The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) has made funding available to colleges and universities to assist eligible students who have been impacted by COVID-19. The funds are targeted to give students grants to cover their expenses related to the disruption of campus operations because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

To determine recipients, Anderson considered all undergraduate students that had completed a FAFSA for the 2021-22 award year. Based on guidance that institutions must prioritize grants to students with exceptional financial need, only those students who had a higher cost of attendance than their calculated expected family contribution (EFC) were awarded grant funds.

You have been awarded a HEERF Grant in the amount of \$XXX for the spring 2022 semester. A refund of this grant amount will be issued via the refund payment method you have chosen. If you have not made a selection within your Enterprise Account, a check will be issued. Please note: It will take 7-10 additional business days to receive a refund if a check is processed.
