Upon arrival, your tour guide will meet you at the airport terminal and assist you to the coach bus. You'll start with a half day sightseeing tour and a visit to the Palace of Holyroodhouse (admission included), which stands at the end of Edinburgh's Royal Mile. Explore the Palace's close associations with some of Scotland's most well-known historic figures such as Mary, Queen of Scots and Bonnie Prince Charlie, and learn how today it is used by The Queen when carrying out official engagements in Scotland.

Next, you'll tour the St Giles' Cathedral (admissions included), the High Kirk of Edinburgh positioned at the heart of the Scottish capital. St Giles' was founded in 1124, and in the 16th century became the focal point of the Scottish Reformation. The church is regarded as the Mother Church of World Presbyterianism and welcomes visitors from all corners of the globe. After the tour you'll arrive at your hotel for check in and rest.

Sunday, March 03 Edinburgh

After breakfast, meet your tour guide and start a walking tour. You'll visit the Edinburgh Castle (admissions included), a historic fortress which dominates the skyline of Edinburgh, the capital city of Scotland, from its position on the Castle Rock. Archaeologists have established human occupation of the rock since at least the Iron Age, although the nature of the early settlement is unclear. And, visit to the John Knox House (admissions included), the oldest medieval building surviving on Edinburgh's Royal Mile. It is associated with one of the most turbulent times in Scottish history - the Reformation - and one of its leading figureheads, John Knox.

Monday, March 04 Edinburgh - Durham - Cambridge

This morning, check out of the hotel, and then board a private coach for your departure from Edinburgh to Cambridge. En route you'll stop in Durham for a 3 hour tour with a local tour guide. You'll visit the Durham Castle (admission included) and a Durham Cathedral (admission included), the greatest Norman building in England, perhaps even in Europe. Visit Durham Cathedral, the Tower, the Monks' Dormitory, audio-visual Story of Saint Cuthbert and Durham Cathedral, the Undercroft Restaurant and Cathedral Shop. Then continue on to Cambridge. Upon arrival, check in at the hotel for overnight.

Today, meet your tour guide and board a coach for a day tour of London and Hampton Court. With plenty of photo opportunities! You will visit the Westminster Abbey (admission included), which has been the coronation church since 1066, and is the final resting place of 17 monarchs. It's one of the most important Gothic buildings in the country, and has the medieval shrine of an Anglo-Saxon saint at its heart. You'll conclude your tour with the visit to the Hampton Court Palace (admission included).
